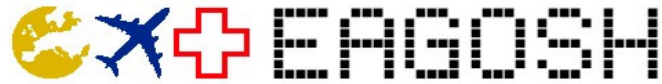

Farewell Rainer Glaesemer

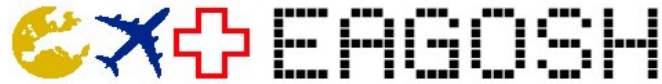
