Our 1st Charter (03 May 2000)

EUROPEAN AVIATION GROUP for OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH (EAGOSH)

CHARTER

- EAGOSH is an organisation committed to the promulgation of a safe place of work, safe plant and machinery, safe work procedures and safe people working in the aviation industry.
- EAGOSH will seek joint co-operation, from all organisations involved in aviation and aviation-related safety and health-related issues, to recommend, formulate and pursue safety policies and practices.
- The Group will strive to achieve and maintain the highest standards of overall health and safety in the operational standards of its member organisations, and within the industry.
- The Group will provide a forum for the open exchange of European Aviation safety related information. It will encourage communication, and works to proactively improve health and safety within the aviation industry.
- 5. EAGOSH is an organisation open to the following membership:
- 5.1 Full membership (voting power) is available to all organisations directly involved in the aviation industry (including airport authorities)

5.2 Affiliated membership (non-voting power) is available to organisations not directly involved but contributing to health and safety in the aviation industry e.g. manufacturers, consultants, authorities etc.

5.3 The BoD will determine the membership status

5.4 The assembly of full members will determine an annual membership fee

- The assembly consists of the full members present at an assembly meeting to take place at least annually. Each full member will be entitled to one vote.
 - The assembly of full members will elect for a term of four years the executives of the Board as proposed by the existing BoD. The BoD consists of 9 members including the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Press Officer, and Membership Officer.
 - EAGOSH seminars will be held twice a year or at a frequency decided by the assembly. The BoD in consultation with the members will administer themes, venues and organisation.


